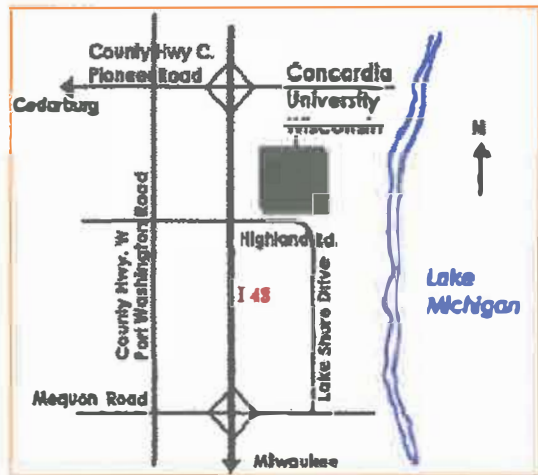

We are located about 20 miles north of Mitchell International Airport in Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

Directions to campus from the south:

- Take Interstate 43 north to Exit 85 (Mequon Rd.)
- Turn left onto Mequon Rd.
- Turn right (north) at the stoplight onto Port Washington Rd. (Hwy W)
- Go north 2 miles, then turn right (east) at the stoplight onto Highland Rd.
- Take Highland Rd. to campus main entrance (on your left).

Directions to campus from the north:

- Take Interstate 43 south to Exit 92 Pioneer Rd. (Hwy. C)
- Turn right (west) onto Pioneer Rd.
- Quick left at the stoplight (south) onto Port Washington Rd. (Hwy W)
- Go 2 miles south, then turn left (east) at the stoplight onto Highland Rd.
- Take Highland Rd. to campus main entrance (on your left).

Once you get to campus: Turn left from Highland Rd. into the CUW entrance on the south end of campus. At the stop sign, turn right (east) toward Lake Michigan. Follow the driveway around to the stop sign. Turn left and park in Lot A or Lot B. Enter Luther Hall and follow conference signs to Albrecht Terrace Room.
